WILLIE ALBERT MACK, WILLIE JAMES SPIVEY, MILDRED SPIVEY,
BROZI GORDON, EDDIE SAVAGE. CURTIS GARNER, AND LORA NELL SAVAGE ALL
ADVISED THEY WERE WITNESSES TO THE MARCH, WERE CHASED BY THE POSSE
MOUNTED ON HORSEBACK AND ONE POSSE MEMBER IDENTIFIED BY THEM AS
E.P. WALLACE RIDING A HORSE NAMED QUOTE "PINE PATCH PETE" UNQUOTE.

MARY LEE WINDFIELD WHO WAS INVOLVED IN MARCH AND ADVISED THAT SHE
OBSERVED NEGROES BEING BEATEN AS FAR AWAY FROM THE DISPERSAL AREA AS
THREE QUARTERS OF MILE. SHE STATED THIS OCCURRED AT BROWNS CHAPEL
AME CHURCH.

JOSEPH BENJAMIN PICKETT, BEULAH LEE JAMES, ADVISED HE WAS ONE
OF THE MARCHERS AND OBSERVED ~~AST~~ ^{ALABAMA STATE TROOPERS} THROWING TEAR GAS BUT WAS UNABLE
TO FURNISH ANY OTHER INFORMATION BECAUSE OF BEING BLINDED BY THE GAS.

CAROLYN ANDERSON OBSERVED MARCHER BEING STRUCK ON UPPER LEFT LIP
BY AST WEARING GLASSES. TROOPER UTILIZED NIGHT STICK TO ASSAULT
THE MARCHER AND SHE WAS UNABLE TO FURTHER DESCRIBE THE TROOPER.
ANDERSON ALSO OBSERVED UNKNOWN NEGRO MALE BEING STRUCK ON RIGHT SIDE
OF HEAD WITH BILLY STICK BY ANOTHER AST, HOWEVER,
