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BLOSSIE WHITE, ROUTE ONE, BOX ONE FIVE TWO, JONES, ALABAMA, WAS DETERMINED TO NOT BE INVOLVED IN MARCH OF MARCH SEVEN LAST AND ONLY REASON SHE APPEARS ON EMERGENCY LIST AT GOOD SAMARITAN HOSPITAL WAS FACT THAT SHE RECEIVED TREATMENT AT HOSPITAL ON THAT DATE OF MARCH SEVEN LAST.

SYLVESTER LUNDY STATES HE BELIEVED SHERIFF JAMES G. CLARK, JR., WAS HIS ASSAILANT; HOWEVER, HE WAS UNABLE TO OBSERVE ANY PHOTOGRAPH WHICH SUBSTANTIATED THIS CONTENTION. VARIOUS PHOTOGRAPHS SET FORTH IN SERIES TEND TO INDICATE CLARK WAS NOT IN POSITION TO STRIKE LUNDY.

LUNDY ADMITS HE WAS ARRESTED FOR ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO MURDER AND SERVED OVER YEAR IN CUSTODY AT COUNTY JAIL. ADVISED HE WAS ALSO TRUSTEE IN OFFICE OF SHERIFF CLARK, THEREFORE KNOWS CLARK ON SIGHT.
