Afternoon. I myself drill a squad Of plebes. Hard cases every mother's Son of them. I am studying Mechanical drawing and chemistry. The Point is my healthy at present Bob Stiles is just up from the meas-Les I suppose it will spread But no more cases have yet made Their appearance. You know I have had them. I heard Robert went up yesterday. Suppose he is well and at home with you all couldnt learn if he had his family along or not. Bob tells me that Robert is coming down I will be Marietta a day or two. I shall be Exceedingly glad to see him.
